
The **Sonoma County Job Market Tracker** is a monthly overview analyzing historical job data and real-time online job posting data to provide insights into current workforce demands of the local economy.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Nearly 9,000 available job openings during the December 2015 monthly reporting period, an
 increase of over 1,700 postings compared to the same period last year capping a year of strong
 employment growth.
- The Retail Trade industry registered the highest number of available job postings with 844 openings, making up 9.6% of available jobs in December.
- The Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing and Hunting industry experienced the fastest growth with a 108% increase in available job openings over the previous period.
- Local unemployment remained steady at 4.2% in November 2015, down from 5.3% in 2014.

MONTHLY TRENDS: There were 8,979 available job openings during the December 2015 monthly reporting period, approximately 28% were new postings.


TOP OCCUPATIONAL GROUPS: The top occupational group is Sales and Related Occupations with 1,517 jobs representing 17% of all available jobs. This is followed by Office and Administrative Support Occupations with 1,119 available jobs, and Healthcare Practitioners and Technical Occupations with 1050 available jobs. The Healthcare Support Occupations saw the highest growth rate over the past year by 115%.





JOB OPENINGS BY LOCATION



TOP 15 JOB OPENINGS: Retail Salespersons has the most available job openings with 444 positions, reflective of retail's busiest time of the year. This is followed by Registered Nurses, and First Line Supervisors of Retail Sales Workers. Both, Customer Service Representatives and Retail Salespersons added more than 100 jobs sequentially. The top employers hiring Customer Service Representatives are Dollar Tree, Gap Inc, Target, CVS Health, and Rite Aid. Target, RadioShack, Sears Holdings, AT&T, and Best Buy make up the top 5 employers posting jobs for Retail Salespersons. Top job openings in the middle to high income salary range include Registered Nurses, First-Line Supervisors of Retail Sales Workers, Retail Salespersons, and First-Line Supervisors of Food Preparation and Serving Workers.

TOP 15 JOB OPENINGS AND ANNUAL MEDIAN SALARIES



TOP 10 HARD SKILLS IN DEMAND: Bilingual is the most sought after hard skill, with **Bilingual Spanish** receiving the 4th most mentions in online job postings. **Behavioral Health, Geriatrics,** and **Pediatrics** are all representative of an expanding health care sector.

TOP 10 SOFT SKILLS IN DEMAND: Oral and written communication skills dominate the soft skills list, representing the most wanted skills that employers are actively looking for. **Microsoft Office** experienced the largest increase over the prior year, followed by **Detail oriented** and **Marketing**.

TOP 10 CERTIFICATIONS IN DEMAND: Driver's License trumps as the most wanted certification in Sonoma County, and **Commercial Driver's License** comes in 5th. The biggest increase has been in **Certification in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation**, with **Certified Registered Nurse** and **Basic Life Support** rounding out the top 5 certifications in demand for December; a reflection of the continually brimming healthcare sector.
