#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Over 9,000 job postings were advertised in July 2016, an increase of 759 postings compared to the same period last year.
- With 836 postings, the Retail Trade industry had the most job postings in the July reporting period.
- Santa Rosa had 215 new job postings since July 2015, as it continues to have the most job postings of any Sonoma County city.

#### **MONTHLY TRENDS**

July 2016 saw 9,136 job postings, of which 31% were new postings. The county unemployment rate remained stable at 4.2% in June and July 2016 after hitting a 15-year low of 3.4% in May 2016. Along with steady job growth, wages have been rising according to the BLS. Average weekly wages in Sonoma County increased 10% from Q4 2014 to Q4 2015, outpacing U.S. (4.4%) and California (5.4%), ranking Sonoma County second among the 343 largest counties nationwide.<sup>1</sup>



#### **OCCUPATIONAL GROUPS**


The top occupational group is **Sales and Related Occupations** with 1,494 jobs representing 16% of all job postings in July 2016. This is followed by **Healthcare Practitioners and Technical Occupations** with 1,092 postings, and **Office and Administrative Support Occupations** with 1,017 postings, accounting for 12% and 11% of all postings respectively. **Transportation and Material Moving** and **Building and Grounds Cleaning and Maintenance Occupations** saw the greatest growth over the past year by 106.95% (400 jobs) and 41.92% (70 jobs) additional job postings.

## Occupational Groups - Top 10 by job posting volume difference from July 2015 to July 2016






#### **OCCUPATIONS**

Heavy and Tractor-Trailer Truck Drivers had the most job postings in July 2016 with 417 positions, followed by Registered Nurses and First-Line Supervisors of Retail Sales Workers. Of the Top 15 Occupations, demand for Heavy and Tractor-Trailer Truck Drivers, Marketing Managers, Maids and Housekeeping Cleaners, and Financial Services Sales Agents increased the most over the year. Retail Salespersons, Registered Nurses, and First-Line Supervisors of Retail Sales Workers experienced weaker job demand as compared to the previous year, yet still remain among the top 5 job postings.

Top employers hiring **Heavy and Tractor-Trailer Truck Drivers** today include *SAIA, Mendocino Forest Products, Werner Enterprises,* and *Transco Lines*. In addition, *St. Joseph Health System, Sutter Santa Rosa Regional Hospital, Kaiser Permanente,* and *Sutter Health* are the top employers hiring **Registered Nurses** and for **First-Line Supervisors of Retail Sales Workers** it is *GameStop, Chico's, Peet's Coffee and Tea,* and *Target Corporation*.


Top job openings in the upper middle to high income salary range (\$50K-\$100K) include Medical and Health Services Managers, Marketing Managers, Sales Agents, Financial Services, Registered Nurses, Sales Representatives, Wholesale and Manufacturing, Except Technical and Scientific Products, and Heavy and Tractor-Trailer Truck Drivers.

Occupations – Cities by job posting volume from July 1-31, 2016






#### Occupations – Top 15 job postings by job posting volume from July 1-31, 2016




## Occupations - Top 15 job postings by median salary from July 1-31, 2016

Of the Top 15 job openings in Sonoma County, Marketing Managers, Heavy and Tractor-Trailer Truck Drivers, and Medical and Health Services Managers had the highest hiring difficulty in July 2016. Employers hiring Marketing Managers include Athleta, Best Version Media, Gap Inc., and Kendall Jackson.





#### HARD SKILLS, SOFT SKILLS & CERTIFICATIONS

**Bilingualism** continues to be the number one listed hard skill while experience with **Pediatrics** had the largest percentage increase from the prior year (57.01%).

Demand for all soft skills has fallen from the prior year by an average of 5.15%, which may reflect increasing prioritization of hard skills over soft skills. **Oral and Written Communication**, **Customer Service Oriented**, and **Detail Oriented** were most sought after soft skills.

**Driver's License** continues to be the most wanted certification in Sonoma County by more than double the ad volume compared to the next closest certification. Seven of the top 10 certifications grew in ad volume compared to the previous year. The biggest increase has been in **Commercial Driver's License** (166.20%), followed by **Interventional Cardiologist** (114.52%), **Hazmat** (51.43%), and **Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation** (25.19%).

# Sonoma County Job Market Tracker July 2016

INDUSTRY SPOTLIGHT - Education August 1, 2015 – July 31, 2016

There were 932 job postings for Sonoma County recorded in the Education Industry from August 1, 2015 to July 31, 2016, a decrease of 33.52% from the previous year. The majority of job postings were for positions located in Santa Rosa (62.98%), followed by Petaluma (11.16%), and Rohnert Park (5.47%).

The industry's most advertised occupation is **Teaching Assistants** representing 12.23% of the available job postings followed by **Elementary School Teachers (Except Special Education)** representing 6.97%, and **Secondary School Teachers (Except Special and Career/Technical Education)** representing 5.79%.

Employers in the Education Industry increasingly look for candidates with the following soft skills: Oral and Written Communication Skills, Strategic Planning, Marketing, Work Independently, and Customer Service Oriented. In addition, there is strong demand for the following hard skills: Bilingual, Recruitment Advertising, Productivity Software, Academic Affairs, and Adobe InDesign. The annual median salary from online job postings for the Education Industry in Sonoma County is \$52,350, 6.02% less than the \$55,500 median salary for all industries. The Education Industry experienced a moderate hiring difficulty of 46 (1 = easiest to hire, 100 = hardest to hire) from August 1, 2015 to July 31, 2016.


