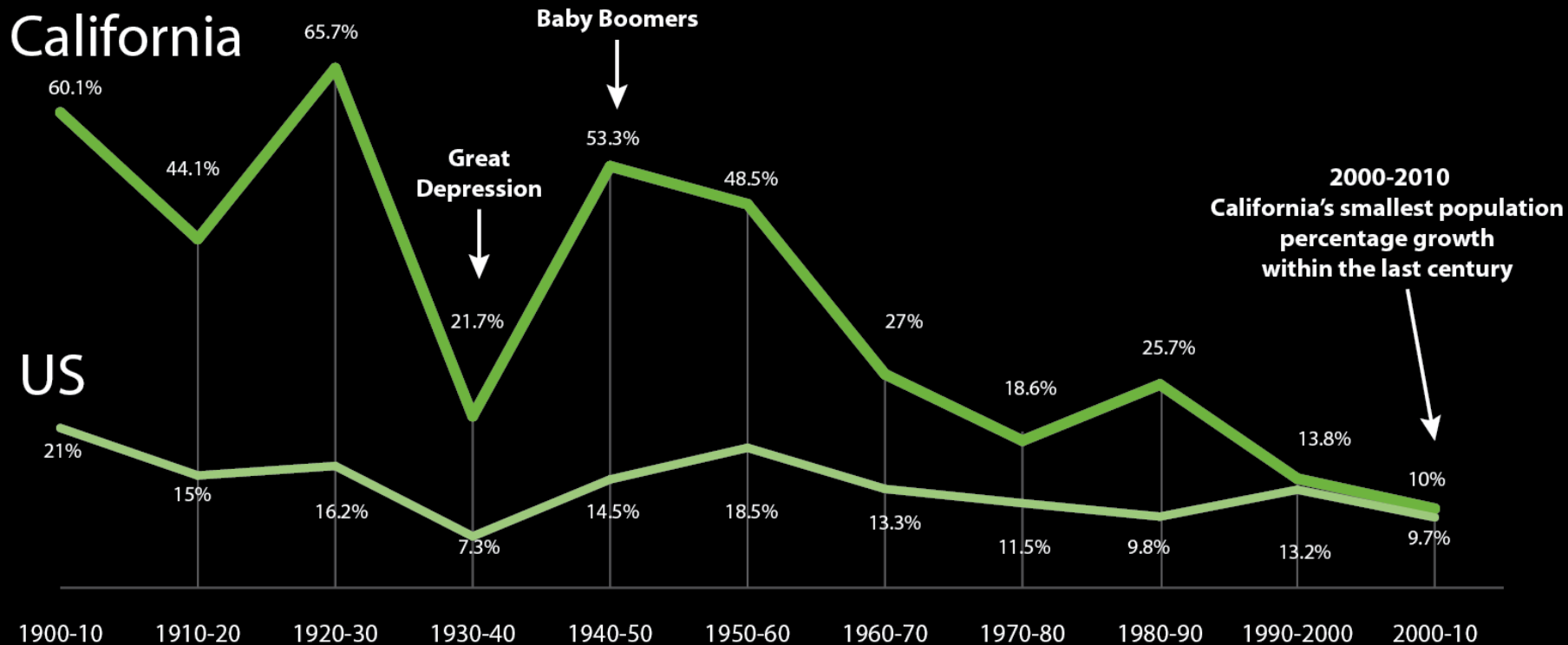

U.S. and California POPULATION GROWTH

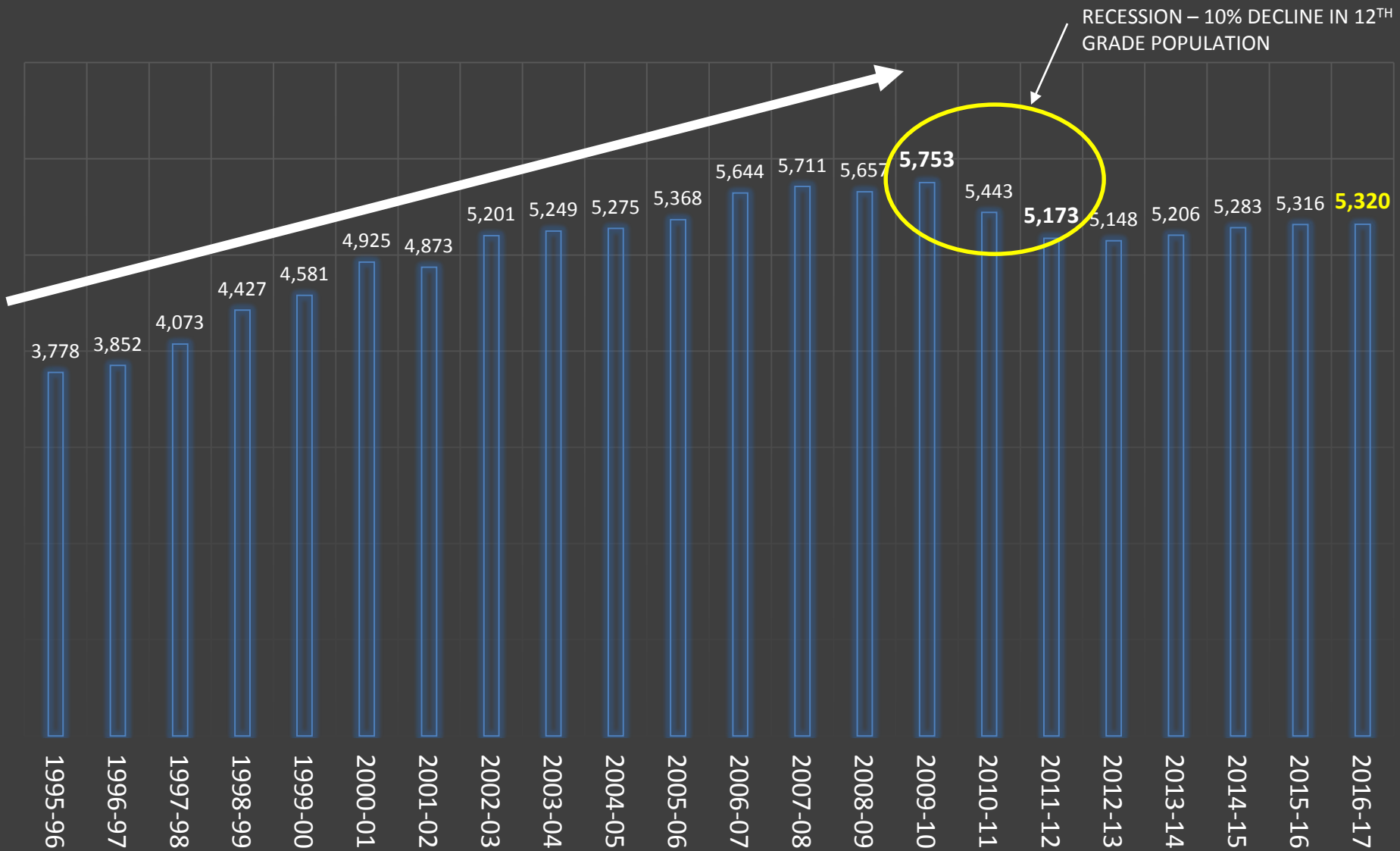

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Sonoma County Public High Schools 12th Graders (22 Year Trend)

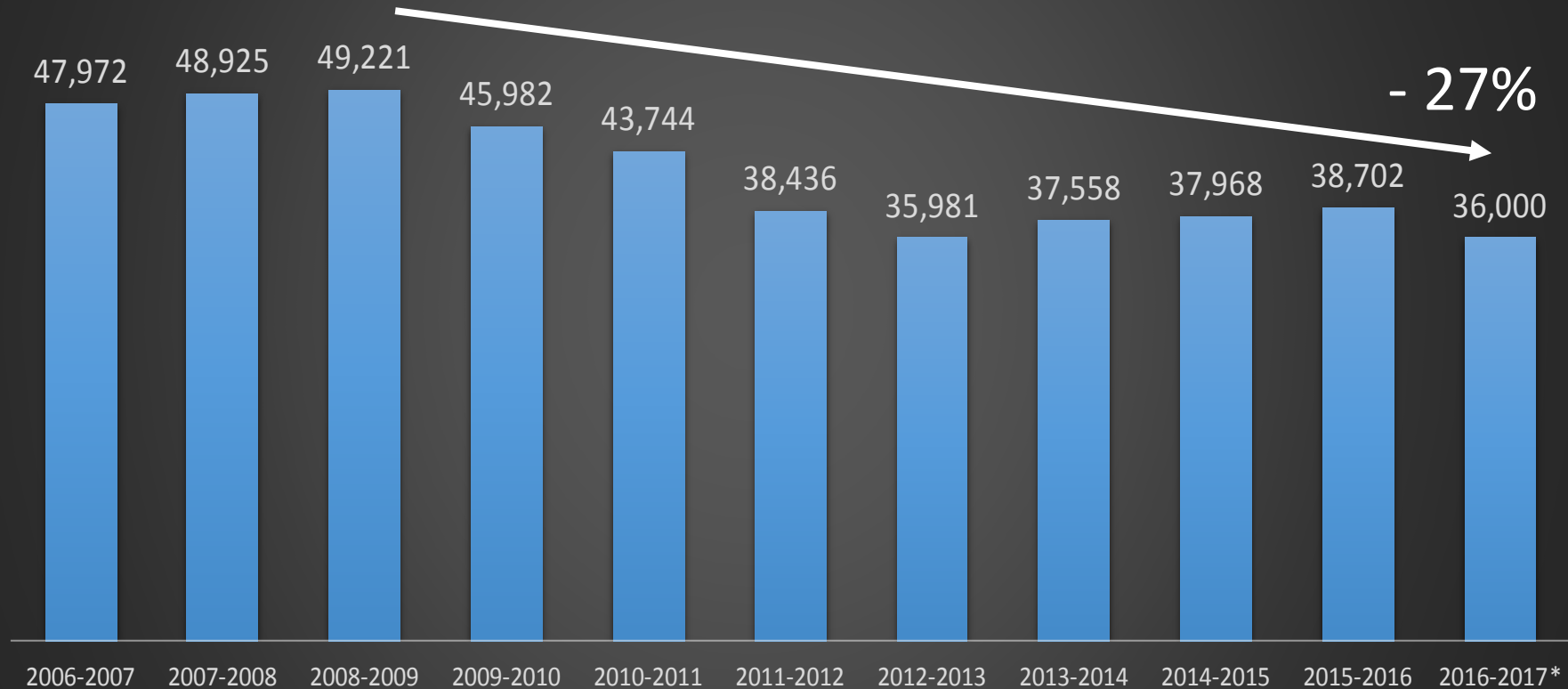

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Sonoma County Junior College District: Annual Unduplicated Headcount



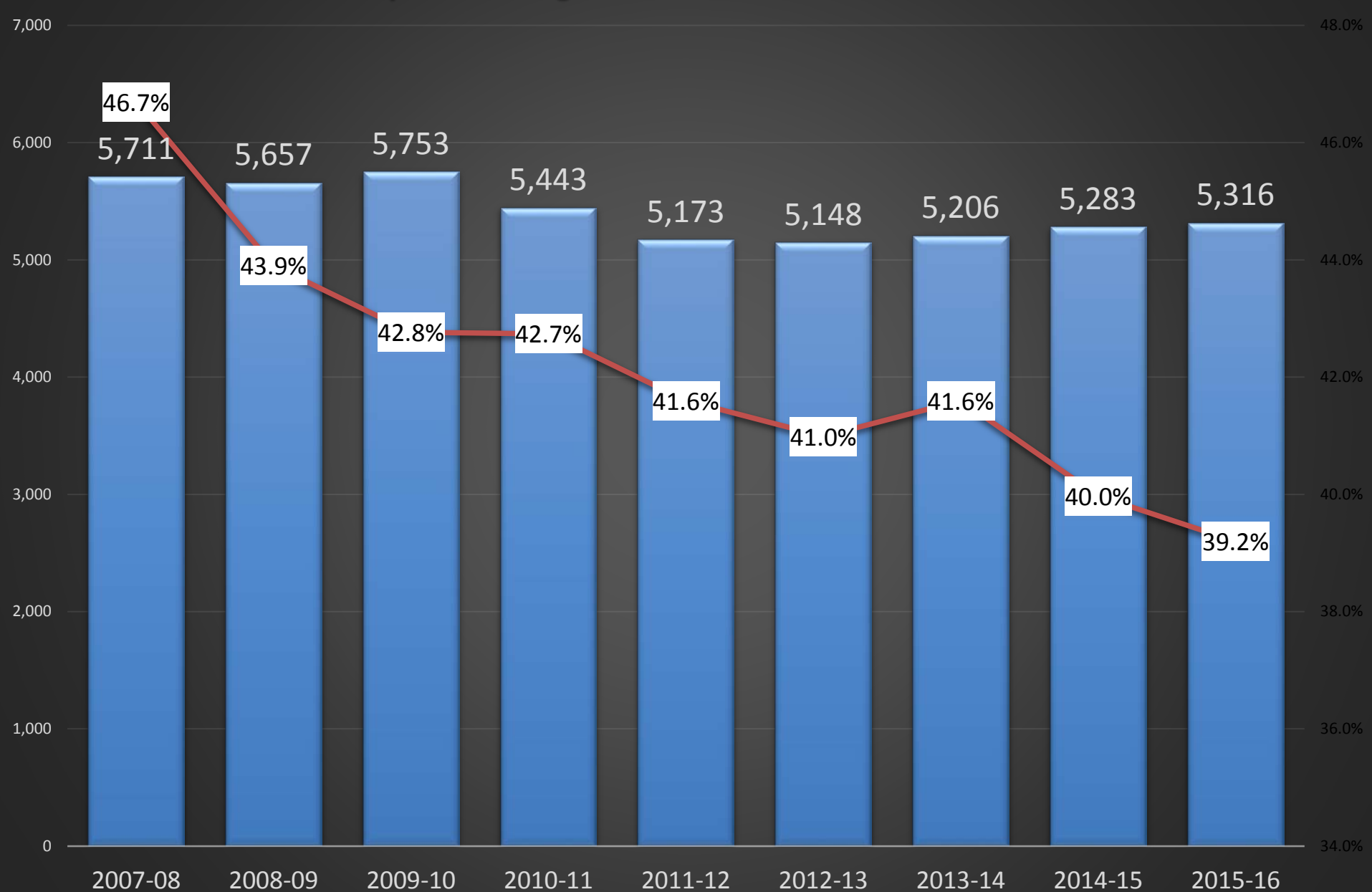

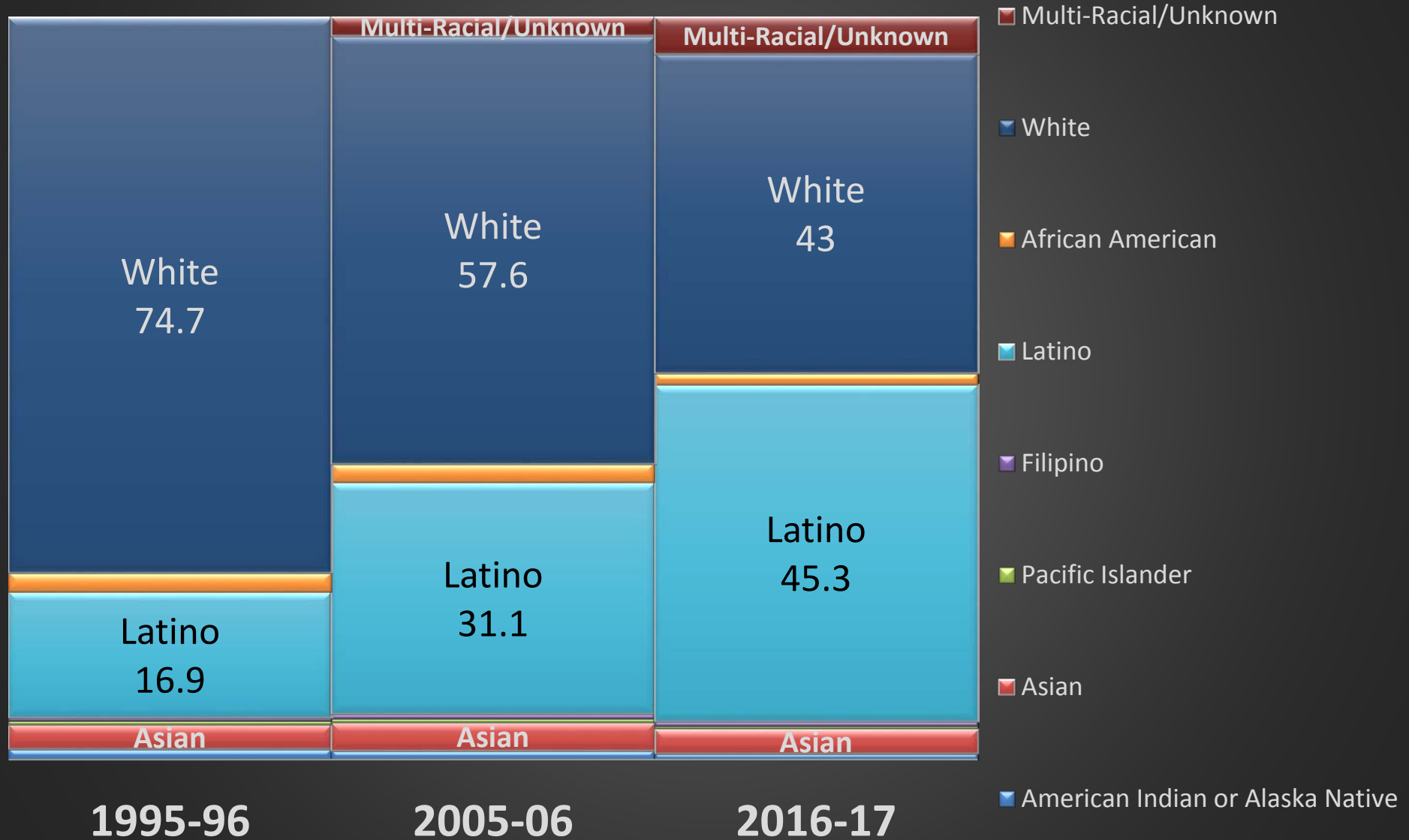
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Sonoma County Public High Schools - % of Seniors Enrolled at SRJC

Sonoma County Public K-12 Student Demographics - 21 Year Trend (%)

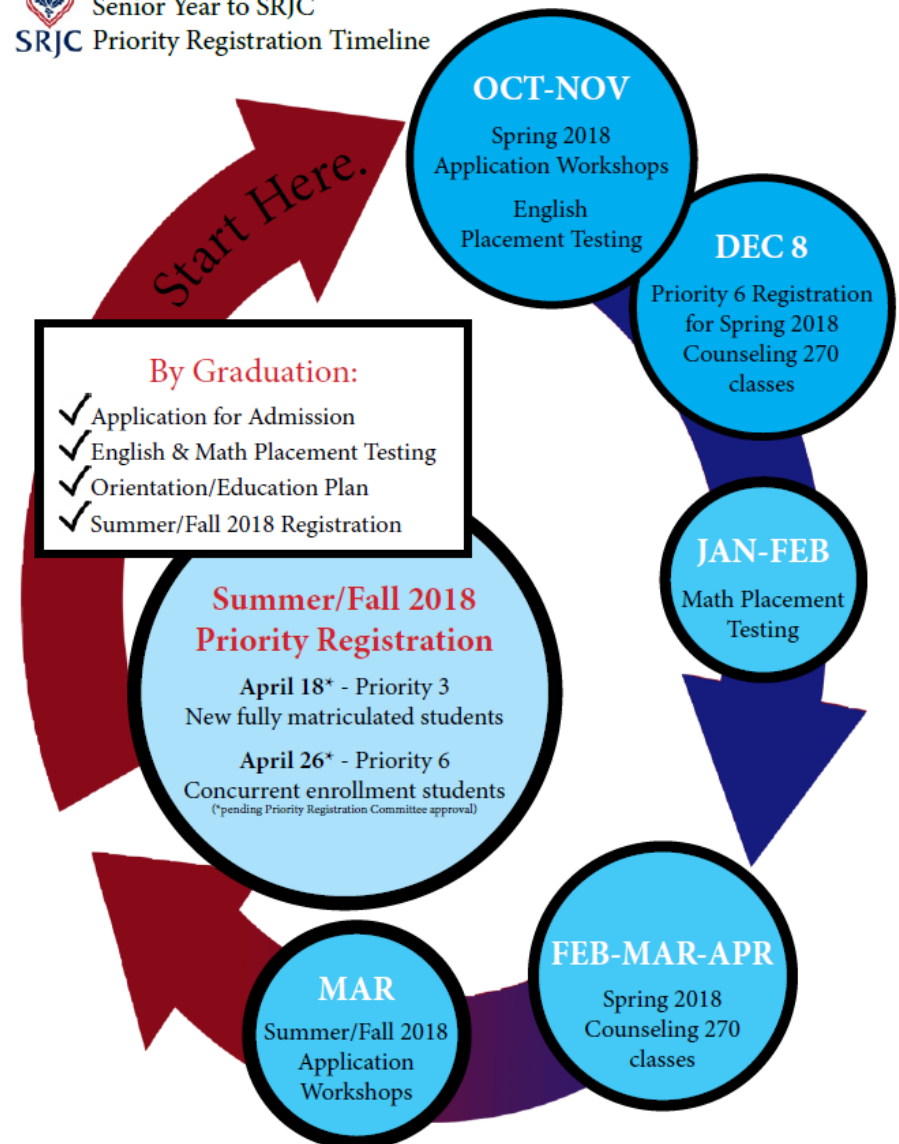

Disability Resources



DISABILITY RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

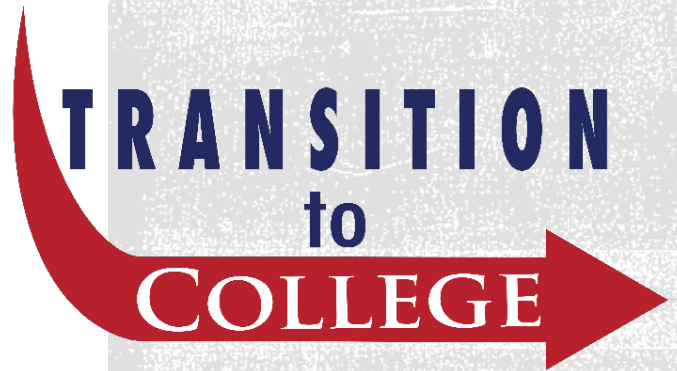
Graduating high school seniors who have a verifiable disability may be eligible to receive services through SRJC's Disability Resources Department (typically students receiving special education or 504 services in high school are eligible for Disability Resources' services).



The **Transition to College** program supports high school seniors with disabilities to prepare for their SRJC experience.

Eligible students have the opportunity to:

- Take placement exams with extra time prior to Summer/Fall registration
- Develop an education plan
- Fulfill college orientation requirement
- Meet with a disability specialist to determine accommodations
- Learn about campus resources
- Utilize CANVAS, SRJC's online portal for course content



Eligible students work with a specialist to determine needed accommodations.

ACCOMMODATIONS are authorized supports that are based upon the limitations from a particular disability.

Some examples include:

- Note-taking assistance
- Extra time for exams or timed writing assignments
- Alternate media, such as electronic textbooks
- ASL Interpreters
- Option to record lecture
- Priority registration
