DESCRIPTION

If you are looking for a summer job, MMWD has opportunities for enthusiastic workers. **Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.** We have 4 positions available in the Facilities and Watershed Division and 2 positions available in Meter Operations. These assignments are for a 40-hour week, Monday through Friday. All positions operate out of MMWD's Corte Madera location.

THE POSITIONS

Vegetation Removal Crew – (4 positions) Assist maintenance crews in performing general maintenance at over 150 pump and tank sites, district buildings, facilities, and landscape. Ability to perform heavy physical work, minor mechanical work, general maintenance and clean up duties, and lift up to 50 pounds. **Safety boots required.** Work hours are 6:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Meter Box Maintenance – (2 positions) Work with regular crews to prune vegetation around meter boxes, perform general cleaning and maintenance of boxes, and assist with installing or replacing meters and meter boxes. Ability to perform heavy physical work, work outside in all weather conditions and lift up to 50 pounds; will be working with various hand tools. **Safety boots required.** Work hours are 6:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
